How does Clara solve her conundrum so she loves being herself?



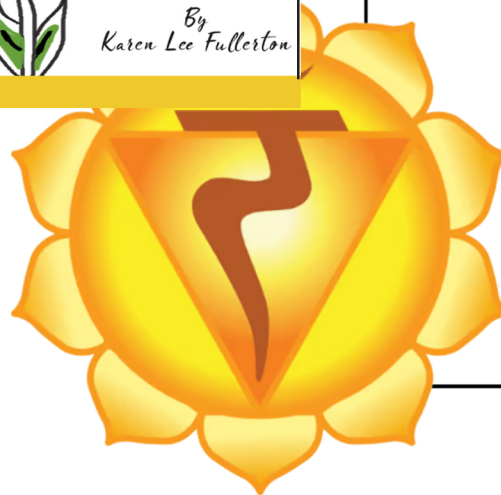
